



DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD TO A PPJS COLLOABORATOR/ALLY
2020 AWARD CRITERIA

This honor is awarded to an individual who is not employed by a PPJS member organization. The nominee should possess experiences that demonstrate they have taken an active role in promoting activities that improve juvenile services and the juvenile system on a local, regional, and/or statewide basis. There will be only one winner in this category. Each member organization may nominate one individual.

Criteria for selection will be based on the following factors:

1. Cannot be presently employed by a PPJS member organization.
2. Has provided support, resources, and/or assistance to the advancement of juvenile services and the juvenile system on a local, regional and/or statewide basis.
3. Should promote the Mission and Vision of PPJS.
4. Should maintain balance within work, family and community

The submission must be ONE page containing the following information:

1. Name of Nominee
2. Current position/title held and the role the nominee fulfills within his/her workplace
3. Number of years employed in current position
4. A narrative explaining the following:
 - a. Contributions the nominee has made to improving detention/shelter at the local, regional and/or state level.
 - b. Explanation of how the nominee has knowingly or unknowingly promoted the objectives of PPJS.
 - c. Involvement in family, community and professional organizations.
 - d. Additional supportive comments.
5. Name of person submitting the nomination and associated detention center name
6. Position of person submitting the nomination
7. Contact phone number of person submitting the nomination
