



**EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR
2020 AWARD CRITERIA**

This honor is awarded to an individual within a PPJS member organization who has served with distinction to enhance educational programming for youth. There will be only one winner in this category. Each licensed entity may nominate one individual. All nominees will be recognized at the annual PPJS conference.

Criteria for selection will be based upon the following factors:

1. Must be a full-time teacher and/or educational administrator in a PPJS member organization.
2. Must hold a current State of Pennsylvania teacher's certificate.
3. Must have held this position for a minimum of two years prior to nomination.
4. Is actively engaged in developing and implementing creative educational programming for students at-risk consistent with the principles of Balanced and Restorative Justice.
5. Works to promote a sense of "team" between all factions of the agency and serves as a model of dignity and respect for his/her students.

The submission must be ONE page containing the following information:

1. Name of Nominee
2. Organization Name
3. Number of years employed at the organization
4. Current position/title held
5. A narrative explaining the following:
 - a) Contributions by this individual to the enhancements of educational programming within the facility.
 - b) Specific examples of interesting, unique and creative educational programming which this individual has developed and implemented.
 - c) The individual's ability as a motivator of reluctant learners, and his/her effectiveness in impacting positively upon student attitudes toward school and learning.
 - d) A description of the individual as a role model for students and one who promotes a sense of "team" within and between the various factions serving the facility.
 - e) Additional supportive comments.
